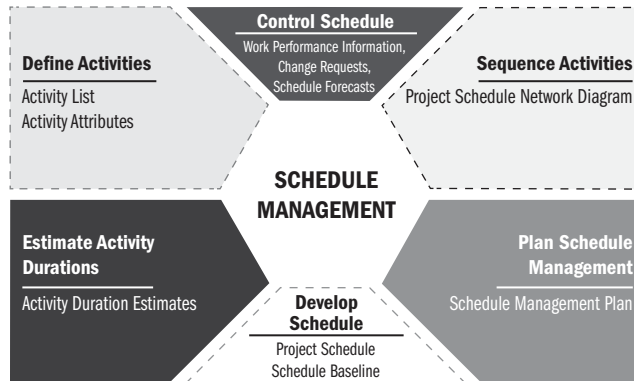

"173. B is the best choice. The question leaves 2 clues - that we are concerned with the Scope Management topic and specific monitoring and controlling processes. There are 2 M & C processes in this knowledge area: Validate Scope and Control Scope. Therefore, we can eliminate Answers-A and -D. Answer-B is the correct, short summary of this process of Validate Scope. **Answer-C is not accurate for Control Scope.**"
